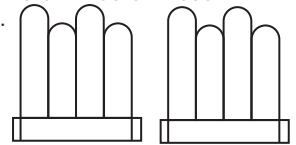
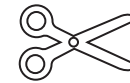

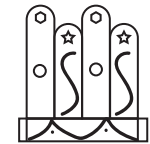
Paper Crown

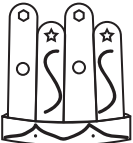
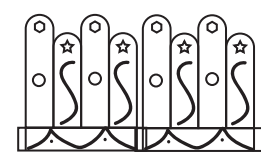
- 1** Print and cut two or three of these paper crowns.



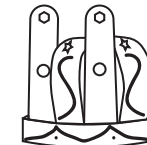
- 2** Colour in the crown. You can also decorate it with feathers, glitter and gems.

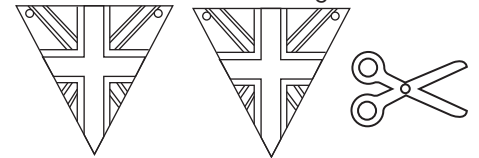

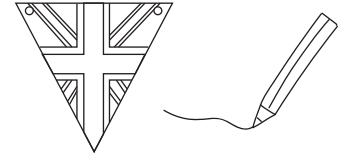
Bunting

Instructions:

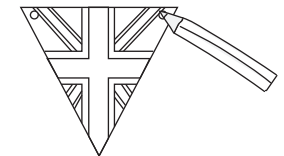
- 1 Print and cut out all of the triangles. You can print out as many as you want to make it longer!



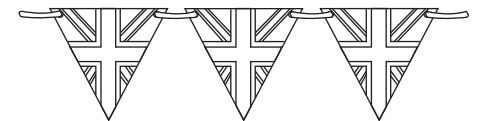
- 2 Colour in the bunting

- 4 Thread some string through the holes to create your bunting.



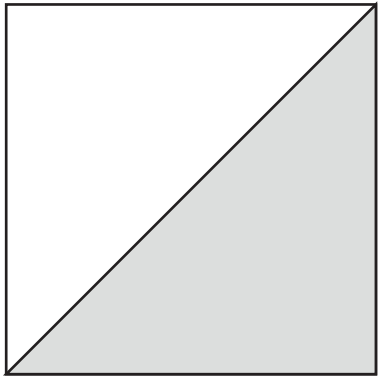

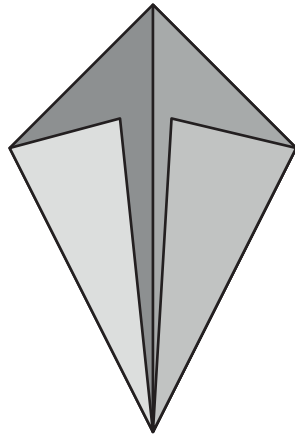

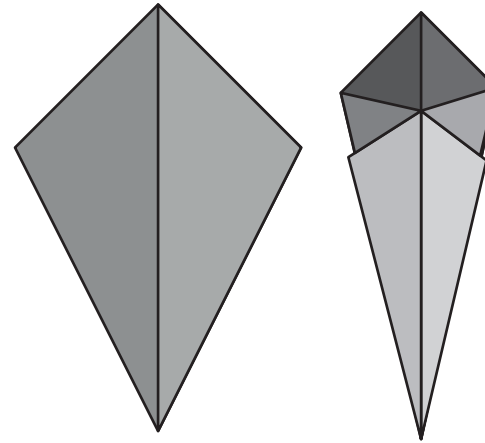
Origami Swan



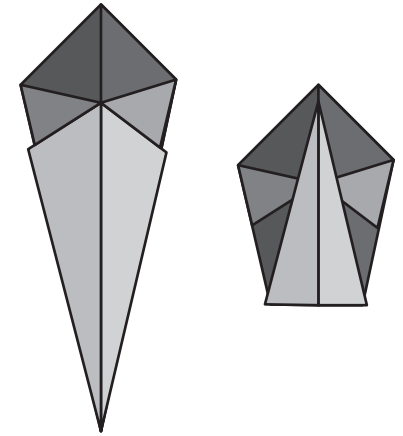
1 Take a square piece of paper and fold it in half from one corner to the other



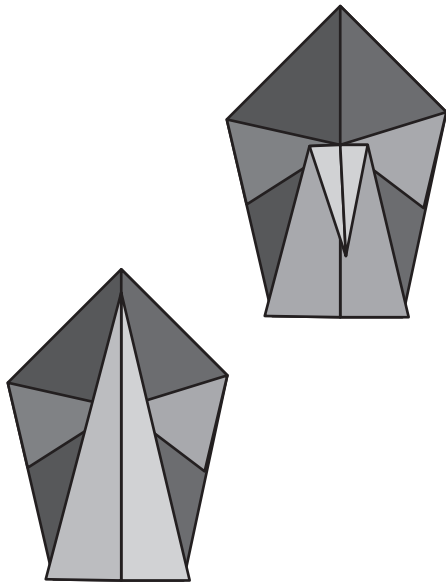
2 Fold two corners into the centre of the square



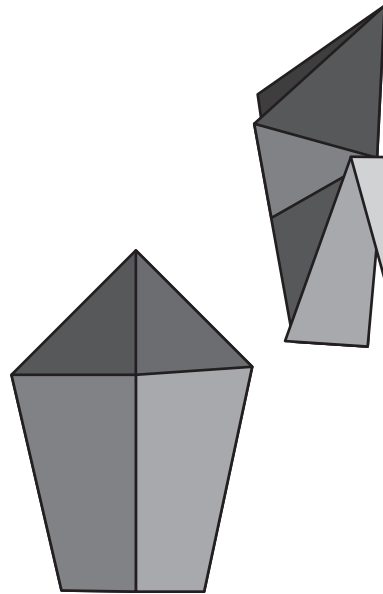
3 Flip over the diamond and fold the two corners into the centre again.



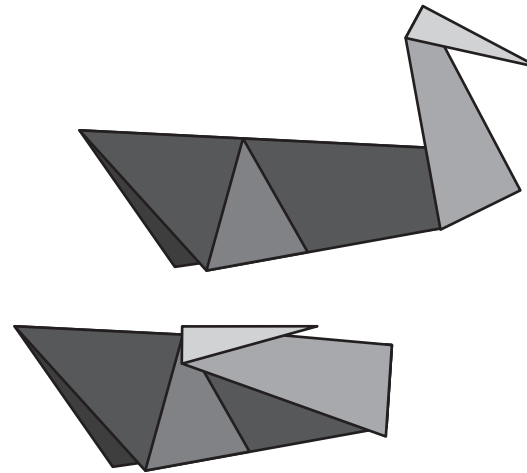
4 Fold the bottom of the diamond up to the opposite point



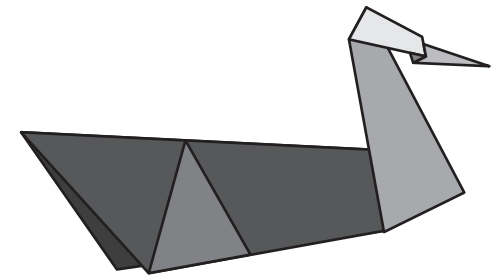
5 Fold the top triangle to the centre to create the swans head



6 Flip over and fold the swan in half



7 Take the neck of the swan and bring it up and fold it to the angle that you want



8 Push the beak back half way to create a fold into itself
